# **WFHS Band Booster Chaperone Duties**

### Before departing the school:

- 1. Verify water coolers are on the trailer, filled and ready
- 2. Verify snacks are on the bus with a chaperone
- 3. Assist students getting on the bus
- 4. Assist loading the trailer, if applicable
- 5. Ensure the rope and emergency box are on the trailer
- 6. Towing the trailer

#### On the Bus:

- 1. Ensure snacks are on the bus, when appropriate
- 2. Monitor student behavior
- 3. Assist Mr. Ewing with any requests he might have
- 4. Assist the Bus Driver with any requests he/she might have

## At a football game:

- 1. Carry coolers and snacks into the stands
- 2. Carry equipment or instruments, if needed
- 3. Rope off the band area
- 4. Ensure no spectators pass through the band area
- 5. Ensure only Marching Knights are in the band area
- 6. Monitor student behavior

- 7. Pass out water (1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarters) and snacks (3<sup>rd</sup> quarter)
- 8. Collect trash when appropriate
- 9. Watch instruments, bags, and equipment (including sound system) when the students and/or Mr. Ewing are not in the stands (while performing and on 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter break)
- 10. Monitor students who have lost 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter break
- 11. Be available for any requests by Mr. Ewing

#### At a parade:

- 1. Follow behind or alongside the band
- 2. Ensure no spectators enter the band's formation
- 3. Hand out waters when needed
- 4. Collect empty bottles when needed
- 5. Monitor student behavior
- 6. Monitor student well-being (look for signs of exhaustion)
- 7. Assist Mr. Ewing with any requests he may have

All chaperones are expected to follow the local and state laws, as well as all SCCPSS rules and the WFHS Band Handbook when chaperoning at any event.
